Guidelines for Competition Coordination



- Please designate a Coordinator and a Teacher-in-Charge to manage the competition.
 - We request you to review the competition themes in the brochure (KG/BV1 – Class 12) and encourage maximum participation. Please promote this event via school circulars, notice boards, assemblies, messaging portals, and Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs).
 - Finalize the competition date, confirm with all stakeholders, and notify the TRUST.
 - Fill out and complete the Response Sheet, obtain the Principal/HM's signature, and submit a scanned copy or clear photo via WhatsApp or email.
 - Set a specific deadline for students to pay the Rs. 101 Entry Fee. Retain Rs. 13 per student for administrative expenses, and transfer the remaining Rs. 88 per student to the TRUST SB A/C No: 520101078074289 (via UPI, IMPS, NEFT, RTGS, or DD). Once the payment is done, please WhatsApp or email the following to the TRUST: Transaction screenshot, 12-digit UTR/Reference number and Student details (e.g., name, class, contact).
 - Please arrange printing of the digital portrait outline (provided by the TRUST) for each participant in Pre-KG to Class 2. Kindly use good quality A4-size paper. Please utilize the Rs. 5/- allocation from each student's entry fee to cover the printing and paper costs.
 - Kindly make arrangements to print the TRUST digital format on high-quality A4 size paper for all Painting and Poster-Making contestants from Classes 3 to 12. The associated printing costs are to be met from the Rs. 5/- entry fee collected from each participant.
 - All paintings and posters must be completed on-site. Participants are required to bring their own stationery and art materials.
 - Collect all completed artwork immediately after the competition and send it to the TRUST.
 - To ensure a fair and exciting competition for everyone, each category requires a minimum of 15 participants to activate reward eligibility.
- If a category falls short, we may combine groups to guarantee a robust event. There is no maximum limit, so maximize your involvement and help us elevate the competition!.
- State Champions: Minimum of 10 Schools Per State and 5 Per UT required to validate the championship category.
 - Winners will be chosen by an independent panel; their decision is final and binding.
 - The organizers reserve the right to cancel or consolidate award categories based on entry volume.
